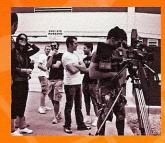

Course 1: MOVIEMAKING WORKSHOP
(8 weeks, Thursdays 7pm to 10 pm)
We will explain the 6 steps in Filmmaking:
Development, Pre Production, Production, Post
Production, Distribution and Marketing.
Instruction touches on screenwriting basics, choosing
story, business plan and funding, choosing locations,
preparing for auditions, casting talent (both pros and
extras), directing, and preparing to shoot a feature film.
Heavy emphasis on Production:

Formats, HD cameras, lenses, lighting, microphones and sound capture;

Hands-on equipment setup and tests, with professional HD cameras; Video editing, music and sound mixing tools FCP editing software.

Includes shooting video to create both good and bad results in visual, sound and lighting, then examining the differences.

Other Topics: Filmspeak "language" and continuity; wardrobe, makeup; acting for camera; working with SAG and other talent; Procedures (reading, rehearse, block, light, shoot) & media handling. We will shoot representational situations and concentrate on who does what and when so they function like a real film crew.

Certificate awarded upon successful completion.

Course 2: SCREENWRITING WORKSHOP (8 weeks, Wednesdays 630 pm to 9 pm)
Our goal is to assist writers to improve their craft and thus move them closer to production.
Topics include finding the story, character analysis and development, script development, narrative point of view, plotting, subplots and dialogue. In-class, we will break down a feature film script to determine what makes it work; also ind. exercises and group projects are assigned.

Designed for both screenwriters and filmmakers, this program promotes understanding of commercial Narrative Features, TV Pilots, and Web series. Group reading as time permits.

Optional Bonus: Students that complete the program may be offered the chance to earn a credit working on a real movie set, slated to shoot in August, 2011.
